## **ZAKRES OMAWIANEGO MATERIAŁU**

SUBSTANTIVE CRIMINAL LAW:

- overview of substantive criminal law legislation - introduction of criminal legislation (construction, legislative techniques, interpretative principles) - crime and conviction rates

- principles of criminal responsibility, especially taking into consideration regulation and application of the following legal devices: self-defence, concurrence of provisions and crimes, methods of establishing legal causation, experiment as an excusing defence, criminal co-operation, provocation
- system of penalties and principles of their imposition, especially taking into consideration imposition of penalties alternative to imprisonment, electronic techniques of probative supervision, life imprisonment, recidivism, crown witness, victim reconciliation, limiting of penalties imposed for some kinds of crimes, protective penal measures, forfeiture and confiscation
- overview of types of crimes in the specific part of the criminal code especially organized crime, abortion, sexual offences, property offences, fraud and fiscal crimes, corruption)

#### PROCEDURAL CRIMINAL LAW:

- preparatory proceeding
- application of preventive measures, especially preliminary arrest/detention
- admissibility and principles of surveillance
- measures of speeding up of criminal proceedings
- law of evidence
- extent of "equality of arms" principle
- consensual conclusion of criminal proceeding
- application of digital techniques in criminal proceeding
- extent of application of ne bis in idem and res iudicata principles
- summary proceeding
