

CONCERT



Hanka Rybka – versatile singer, born and raised in Podhale in a family caring for folk traditions and customs, for which the music was and is a natural complement to everyday life. Graduate of the Academy of Music in Katowice, Poland, in the vocal and acting department. She participated twice in workshops in singing of the Mozart Summer Academy in Salzburg. She appeared at many folk festivals in the country and beyond its borders. She has won many ethno/folk music competitions such as: V Folk Competition of Polish Radio „Nowa Tradycja” under the leadership of Czesław Niemen – third prize of TV Polonia. In June 2002 Hanka Rybka represented Poland at the 25th Folk Festival of European Broadcasting Union in Pula, Croatia. She recorded an folk album „I to, i to”. This album

was praised by audiences and music environment and was nominated by the Polish phonographic industry „Fryderyk 2004” in the ethno/folk category. She concerts with the chamber Tatra Orchestra conducted by Agnieszka Kreiner. In May 2006 Hanka Rybka took part in a large project for the Polish American Community in Chicago with the participation of The Paderewski Symphony Orchestra.

In 2007 she was invited to the project prepared by the legendary American jazzman Bennie Maupin. The result of this collaborative work is the album “Early Reflections” released in April 2008 in the U.S. market. The record includes variations of jazz, inspired by music of Szymanowski. Record and Hanka’s vocals gathered great reviews. Concerts promoting the album were in the U.S. (LA – Hollywood, New York), Germany (Berlin), Slovakia (Kosice), Italy (Rome, Turin, Marostica, Verona, Ferrara, Villa San Giovanni, Catania, Milan), Switzerland (Geneva), France (Paris) and Poland (Zakopane, Kalisz, Krakow).

In 2012 she was invited by Peter Weiss to a new German-Polish-Portuguese musical project: Jazzpol CRW-CANTUS. Concert tour took place in Germany and Portugal. The year 2013 brought next concerts with the participation of these musicians. In 2017 she was granted an Ministry of Culture and National Heritage special occasion award for many years of activity in culture and promotion of Podhale.

The concert is attended by outstanding musicians, cooperating also with famous stars of the Polish music scene and not only:

| Currency exchange

The Polish currency is zloty (PLN). There are 100 groszy to 1 zloty. Banknotes come in 10, 20, 50, 100, 200 and 500 PLN denominations. Coins come in 1, 2, 5, 10, 20, 50 groszy and 1, 2, and 5 zlotys.

1 EUR = ca. 4.30 PLN 1 USD = ca. 3.78 PLN 1 GBP = ca. 4.80 PLN

Most foreign currencies (such as Euro, the American dollar, the British pound, the Swiss franc, and the Canadian and Australian dollars) are easily exchangeable at the airport, banks and small currency exchange bureaus called "kantor" which are ubiquitous in Kraków. In Poland, there are a large number of cash machines as well as numerous places to exchange money (e.g., banks open on weekdays usually until 17.00, or exchange offices – "kantor"). Most hotels accept payment in Euro or USD, or in major credit cards, some of them may not accept American Express.

| Credit cards

International credit cards (Visa, Mastercard, Eurocard) can be used in most cash machines (ATMs) which are called “bankomat” in Polish. Credit cards accepted in Poland: Visa, MasterCard, American Express. Cash machines, restaurants, taxi, car rental agencies and most shops accept all major credit cards. Cash payments are the most popular payment method in Poland, however credit and debit cards such as MasterCard or Visa are commonly accepted in hotels, shops and restaurants.

| Shops

Common opening hours are 10:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m. Monday – Friday. On Saturday shops usually close at 2:00 p.m. and are often closed on Sundays. Payment in shops: by cash (Polish currency) or credit cards.

| Taxi

In Kraków taxis are usually ordered by phone and are available 24 hours a day. You can also try to get them directly from a taxi rank or hail a taxi on the street. In such instances you should be prepared to pay more. Taxi companies usually accept credit cards and employ English-speaking dispatchers and drivers. There are many taxi companies in Kraków.

The initial fee varies between 6 and 8 PLN, the price per kilometer varies between 2 and 3 PLN. Below we have listed several reasonably priced ones: iCAR (phone +48 12 653 5555), RadioTaxi 919 (+48 12 419 0000), MegaTaxi (+48 12 400 0000).

| Public transport

Kraków has a dense network of public transport with trams and buses. Tickets machines can be found in a number of buses and trams and at some stops. Tickets can also be purchased at newspaper kiosks. A 20 min. ticket is 2,80 PLN, a 40 min ticket is 3,80 PLN, a bus ticket to the airport is 4 PLN. The tickets become valid when punched in the orange (sometimes blue) boxes found on all buses and trams.
